

Derby Talbot Lodge Project

Exciting improvements are coming to Camp Galilee! Jill Derby and Steve Talbot, members of the Galilee Advisory Council and long-term supporters of Galilee, have committed \$150,000 to the project to improve the lower dormitory. This will include a complete renovation of the existing facility, as well as the addition of a meeting room and outdoor gathering area. Although the two "sides" of the building have been called Belmont and Round Mountain, after Nevada mining towns, the entire building itself has never been named. With Jill and Steve's generous lead gift, the building will now be known as the Derby-Talbot Lodge. Thank you to Jill and Steve for their incredible generosity.

Without Jill and Steve's leadership, this project might not have been possible. They are deeply committed to Galilee and wrote: "Since first attending Galilee in 1948, the world has changed in complexity, tenor and pace. In the midst of this restless and unpredictable world, Galilee remains a quiet space of enduring spiritual renewal and grace – an anchor for the soul in a churning sea. We are committed that this treasure of ground and hearts advance and thrive."


To be competitive in attracting and maintaining adult retreat groups, Galilee needs more comfortable and updated accommodations. The lower dorm is increasingly unable to meet modern-day demands for privacy in the bathrooms, comfort in the bedrooms, and it also lacks ADA accessibility. In addition, it is currently not feasible for multiple small groups of 15-25 individuals, the majority of our retreat groups, to meet simultaneously at Galilee, as there is a lack of sufficient meeting space. While the cost of the actual building renovation and expansion is estimated at \$300,000, we plan to raise \$400,000 to allow for an exterior patio area and possible parking requirements.

This renovation will give Galilee the ability to host two parish or diocesan groups at the same time, enabling them to meet separately during the day, then have the option of getting together for meals and evening fellowship. It will also allow, for the first time, groups requiring ADA accessibility to consider Galilee for overnight retreats. The children that attend the science camp experiences with the Great Basin Outdoor School will benefit from the additional program space, in addition to all of our Galilee summer campers. Finally, this project is consistent with our long-term development plan for the camp and retreat center, is aesthetically pleasing, and blends well with the camp environment.



Galilee Campership Fund



You just stepped into St. John's in the Wilderness, the gorgeous church at the center of Camp Galilee. Your eyes haven't adjusted yet from the scorching summer sun, but you immediately hear the voices of a dozen campers. Young teenagers from all over the state are gathered to play "Stump the Chaplain:" a Galilee tradition of challenging the chaplain with their burning questions about life and spirituality. It's almost the end of the week, and this adventure group has built trust through rock climbing, camping out under the stars, singing, and more. You hear evidence of that trust now, as deep conversation brings their diverse lives into new connection with one another. One camper asks about the place of women in the church, and shares about her upbringing in another denomination. A young man responds with a completely different perspective, as Galilee is his first exposure to the Church. Shifting gears, you listen to a young Latina woman from Las Vegas talk about her experience of pushing against racist expectations others have for her, despite the fact that she's an Honor Roll student in AP classes.

Watching this exchange of stories, questions, trust and faith, you see the chaplain and the counselors trade knowing looks as they appreciate the wonder of such an unusual gathering of teenagers. For the most part, these teens do not have other chances to interact. They live in different corners of the state and are often kept separate by differences in class, race, faith practice and the powerful social workings of high school. At Galilee, they have had the rare opportunity to grow together as a family, claiming their shared identity as members of the Body of Christ.

More than a third of the campers who came to Galilee in 2016 were able to do so because they received financial assistance. While we are delighted that camp was accessible to children whose families could not otherwise afford it, the truth is that every camper benefits from the Campership Fund. 


