

Galilee Family Camp Covenant

We face unprecedented times due to the pandemic of COVID-19. Because of the risks associated with this disease, Camp Galilee will require each guest to comply with this Guest Covenant during family camp this summer. **(You will be given a copy of this covenant when you arrive to review with your family. No need to complete this form before your arrival.)**

If CDC or Nevada requirements change, I understand that this covenant may be revised for Camp Galilee to comply with those requirements. Galilee may revise guidelines as situations warrant.

Each family will have their own living space, bedroom/s and bathroom/s, while at Galilee that will not be shared with any other family.

Outdoor activities will require face masks when we are all convening as a community, including around the dining hall when not eating, at the outdoor chapel, and at campfire. I do understand that proper social distancing must always be observed with members of other households.

This is not a typical social stay, and I understand that we may not host anyone in our living space at Galilee who is part of another household. No outside guests will be admitted on the property during your time here.

There will be no housekeeping during your stay.

Children are the responsibility of parents and may not interact with children of other households without social distancing.

I understand that as a guest of Camp Galilee, it is my/our responsibility to help keep our fellow guests and Camp Galilee staff safe.

I/we will review the covenant with all in my party. I realize that if a family camper does not comply, they may be asked to leave Galilee and no refund will be provided.
